

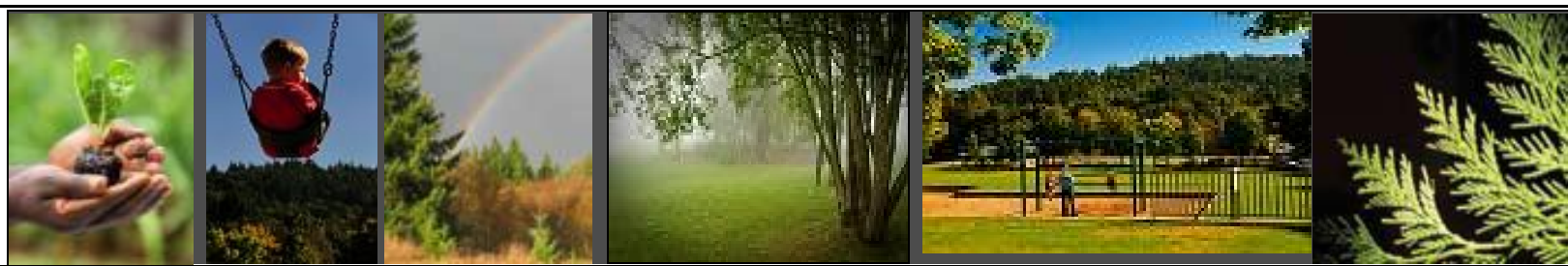


Earth Day in Newcastle
